Till date, the total sponsored amount is Rs. 15,00000\*/- (Rupees Fifteen Lakhs Only) The list of few deserving student's, their background and the support provided are mentioned below:



## Harsha\* | 25-11-2020 |

Harsha - a student with distinction in second PU and performed extremely well in the JEE with EWS ranking of 746, Secured a seat in the Prestigious IIT Varanasi but opted for his stream of engineering in NIT Surathkal, comes with a background of a mother who is on the recovery path of cancer and a father who is not on a good and consistent pay. We have offered full support to him and continue the same till date. Our contributions to this student's studies at Rs. 90,000/- till date.

## Bhagya\* | 29-12-2020 |

Bhagya - An innocent bright Girl who had cleared her third standard exams with 90 plus percent marks had to sit at home due to non-payment of fees by her domestic maid mother and unsupportive father. She required a fee of Rs. 5,000 for the third standard arrears and Rs. 5,600/- for her fourth standard arrears to be admitted to school. She had to be presented a smartphone worth Rs 6000 to facilitate her attendance of online classes



## Rishikesh\* | 06-01-2021 |



Rishikesh - has passed his 3rd year of Engineering with 7.5 CGPA in computer science and required help to pay his fees for the fourth year, his father is only bread winner of the family and is on a low paying blue collared factory job, Vivekananda Kendra and rock Memorial trust recommended this case to us and we have decided to contribute Rs. 25,000/- to the cause and supported him till he was picked up by Infosys in campus interview.

### **Yashika\* | 06-01-2021 |**

Yashika - secured 94.7% in her SSLC exams and opted for a reputed PU College with an annual fee requirement of Rs.1,56,000 of which she had paid 70,000. A dispute between her father and mother led to her mother and Yashika having to leave the house. Her father is married twice and has abandoned Yashika's mother and Yashika. We sponsored Rs. 50,000/- of her remaining fees for the first year and Rs. 85,000/- for the second year



### **Bhargav Gowda\* | 06-01-2021 |**

Bhargav Gowda - A bright student who scored 94% in his SSLC exams was supported by his uncle until now and requires higher monetary support going forward. He dreams of clearing UPSC exams in future and is currently studying in a college in Mysore. His father is supposed to be an alcoholic and not capable of supporting this bright student. We have paid Rs. 22,000/- towards his total fees and Rs. 25,000/- towards his tuitions



### **Vigneshwari\* | 30-01-2021 |**

Vigneshwari - A student studying in 9th standard in a school in Chennai is supported by her single parent mother working as a domestic help. She has scored 84 percent marks in 9th std and required 12,500/- for paying her arrears and her current year fees. We helped her with a contribution of Rs 48,750/- till date as she completes her XI th at Velammal Hr.Sec.School



### **Shivani\* | 30-01-2021 |**

Shivani - A student studying in 12th standard in a school in Chennai is supported by her single parent mother working as a domestic help. She has scored distinction in 10th standard and required support to continue her studies. She is elder sister of Vigneshwari. Our support to her till date Rs.25,000/-

A bright 10th Std student was crestfallen as her father's income as a helper in a hotel was not enough to pay the fees. Being made to stand out of the class for non payment of the fees for very capable kid could lead to life loss physiological scars. Jagruth Bharath is happy to help her with contributions of Rs, 40,000/- her self respect mother wanted to contribute something to the cause and we arranged increase free loans to the tune of Rs, 20,000/- from good Samaritans.

A 9th Std student, high performance girl, happens to be supported by a self employed BPL single mother. Desired by their father, the mother's income could not support Desha's fees and that of her siblings. We have support Disha to the have of Rs, 15,000/- till date and continue to morally back her.

A student was going on smoothly scribbled into unforeseen blocks almost piking an end to his education. Girisha, son of a farm laborer scored 93.76 percentage in SSLC from Dr H Narasimhiah School in Hossur, Chiickballapur. His father is in loans and already stretched to pay the fees for Girisha's elder brother who has opted for computer engineering. Girisha is aspiring to be a aeronautical engineer and is studying in RA Jalappa institute in Dodballapur. We paid 18000 towards his yearly fee when he reached out to us at the fag end of the year without which he could not have sustained his education and moved on to the second year. We have supported him with a laptop to help his programming skills in Java, Python, etc.

### **Ramya\* | 21-04-2021 | 40,000.00**

Ramya is the daughter of a small farmer in Naviladaku Village, Tumkur District, who in last five six years has not been profitable in agriculture due to inconsistent monsoons. Ramya has two elder sisters who had to be married and her father took loans for the same and has struggled paying the loans and interest. Ramya studied in Dr.H Narsimhiah School Hossur, Chickballapur secured 90.56 percentage in SSLC and is aspiring to do very well in UPSC exams and serve the country . She joined Vidyavahini College in Tumkur and had not paid her 1st PU exam fees untill a week before the final exam without which she could not write her exams . She reached out to JB through a known friend and we were very happy to help her pay 40000 fees and continue her future studies. As she gets ready to attend her 2nd PU Exams our support stands at Rs. 75,000/- till date.

This is close to 4 months program timed in a way not to interrupt with the students' regular curriculum. So far 6 students have been enrolled and being benefited.
